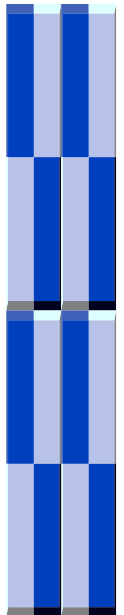

“For excellence / contribution to Agricultural Education in NSW Secondary schools”

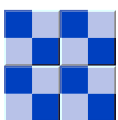

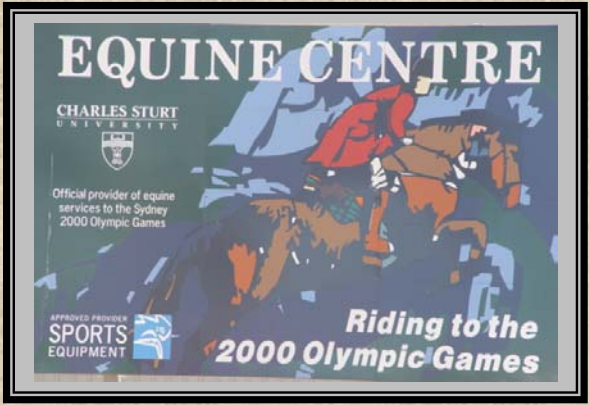
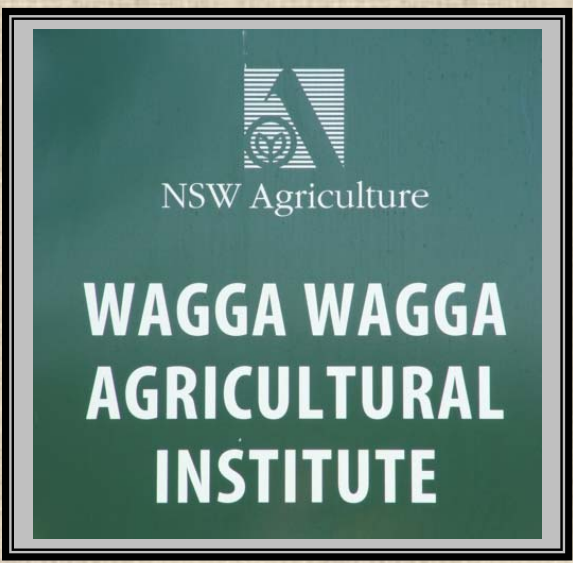
